Arts, Crafts and Museums

Dumfries Art Trail This walking trail links art studios, galleries and shops, all within a 15-minute walk from the High Street. Maps can be downloaded or collected from Visit Scotland (Tourist Information Office - 64 Whitesands, Dumfries, DG1 2RS).

Dumfries & Galloway Aviation Museum This museum, located on the site of the former RAF airbase, gives a handson experience in various aircrafts. Admission: Adults £6.30, Children £4.50, Family £18. Fishing

Loch Ken, Castle Douglas, DG7 3NQ – Pike Fishing in Loch Ken is spectacular and is famed for one angler catching the 'Loch Ken Monster', the largest pike on record in Loch Ken weighting 72lbs and measuring 7 feet in length!

River Annan, Annan, DG12 5PF – The Annan's salmon catch is usually in Scotland's top 20 with weights of 10lbs plus. Castle Loch Fishery, Lochmaben, DG11 1NN - Castle Loch is Scotland's Premier specimen coarse fishery and is located in a serene nature reserve.

The Buccleuch Estates Fishing, Drumlanrig Mains, Thornhill, DG3 4AQ - Here you'll find Salmon and Sea Trout fishing in the River Nith, plus Grayling fishing in the winter. They also offer Rainbow Trout and Brown Trout fishing in the well-stocked lochs.

Birdwatching

Ken Dee Marshes – Ken Dee Marshes is a RSPB reserve just by the west side of Loch Ken and comprise of both wetland and woodland areas for you to explore. In any month you can usually be treated to Red Kite, Wood Warbler, Nuthatch, and many more beautiful species. Sat Nav Details: Castle Douglas DG7 2LY

WWT Caerlaverock – This nature reserve has a variety of habitats including a saltmarsh, grassland, reed beds, ponds and wooded avenues. WWT Caerlaverock is internationally renowned for its flock of Barnacle Geese that arrive each year. Sat Nav Details: Eastpark Farm, Caerlaverock DG1 4RS
